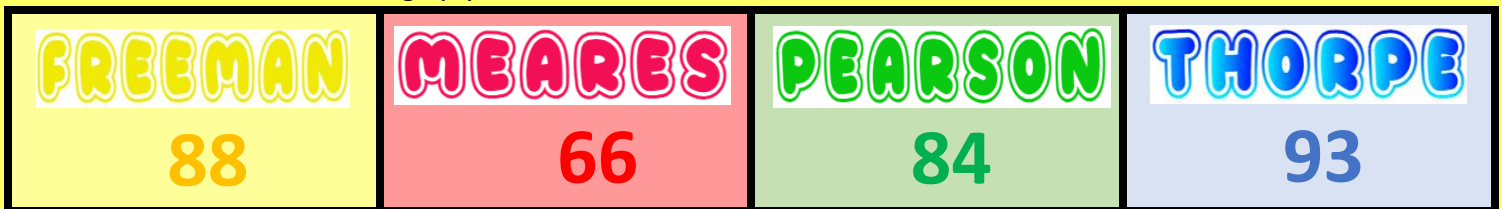
PREMIERS BE ACTIVE CHALLENGE

There were 800 hundred kids, and Roy and Pete got 27th, special mention to them.
