#### **COMMUNITY NEWS**


*Mary Leah* has been involved in Karate for 5 years in the school gym on Tuesday nights. Here is a small reflection of her thoughts.



Dear Parents and Caregivers

On Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> March Week 8, our students will be participating in our annual Sports Day which is aimed at skilling children through athletics, being active and having fun! A program, outlining a detailed order of the day's events is attached so families can prepare for the day.

All new students have been allocated teams and our Year 6 students have submitted and won the school captaincy roles. These will be announced in this week's 'Sports Report'. For our new families, the team names are Freeman (yellow), Pearson (green), Thorpe (blue) and Meares (red). Competitors are encouraged to wear appropriate sun safe clothing in their team colours, with comfortable sports shoes and an approved school hat for the day. Please do not send coloured hair spray to school. Any hair colouring needs to be done at home in the morning.

If your child has medication needs eg for asthma or allergies - please check that it is available for the event and that we have an appropriate up to date health plan in place.

Students will need a water bottle throughout the day and a packed recess and lunch.

Alternatively, we have arranged Subway meal deals for lunch and families will be invited to preorder these lunch requests in the coming weeks. A coffee van will be available for parents during the day and our parent fundraising group will be selling iceblocks (\$1) and other goodies during recess and lunch breaks, with a sausage sizzle operating at lunch time.

We invite all families to attend the day and watch the children in action. We with have designated viewing areas during our morning's events for safety purposes only. During the lunch time break at 12:05pm, children can join you for a family picnic before we begin the afternoon's events.

At the end of the Tug of War, the Sports Day shield will be presented to the day's winning team.

Dismissal will be at normal time, however families that are attending may wish to make arrangements with respective classroom teachers prior to sports day to take their children home following the closing ceremony. The hand over procedure will be that families are to sign out their children with their respective class teachers and depart safely.

If weather prevents Sports Day from going ahead, we will reschedule it for Thursday 28th March in a modified format and all lunch orders will be postponed until then. You can find out by ringing the school at 8.30am or by checking our online communication platforms (Seesaw & EdSmort).
