

Dear parents and carers,

This letter is to inform you of changes to our learning program.

As advised by the Minister for Education and following public health advice, all preschools and schools will remain open:

- In week 10, it is assumed that all children will be attending school where parents prefer or are unable to supervise learning at home.
- In week 11 staff will use pupil free days to set up learning at home and learning at school programs ready for next term.
- Next term, children will be either learning at home or learning on site depending on circumstances.
- Current OSHC services and vacation care will remain open wherever possible.

Next term, if the current levels of isolation continue, school will remain open to provide at-school learning for students. We are also very prepared and well equipped to provide online learning for students remaining at home, and will provide rich learning opportunities, feedback and assessment to them. We respect the decision that you make, and understand that families have a wide range of needs at this time. To assist us in our planning during the pupil free days and over the holidays, we would like you to indicate whether you will be sending your children to school or not. Unfortunately, no schools are able to provide a part-time program to students. You are being asked, as parents in all public schools are being asked, to make the best decision you can now.

Please indicate whether your child will be attending Aldgate Primary School in person or not next term by emailing me directly at leah.kennewell769@schools.sa.edu.au The sooner that we have this information the better.

We will continue to provide updates via email, and all of our usual communication channels. Please do not hesitate to contact us or the OSHC director if you require further information.

Please be assured that continuity of learning of all children, whether they be at school or at home, and the wellbeing of our children and staff will be our highest priority.
