School Dress Code 2017



All students are strongly encouraged to follow the school dress code to promote a positive image of the school and create a sense of identity among students and the community. Please enquire at the front office for further information regarding new and second-hand items.

All clothing worn at school needs to be neat, practical and safe. All items of clothing should be labelled clearly to enable the owners of any lost items to be located. Most items on the Recommended School Dress Code are available from the Front office.

Recommended School Dress Code

- · School material dress, skirt, and pinafore.
- Navy skort.
- School polar fleece.
- School polo (short or long sleeved)
- Navy blue trousers or shorts.
- Hats (broad brimmed or bucket)
- · Beanies, navy polo fleece
- Black, blue, white or brown shoes, plain style sneakers.
- Appropriate and safe sandals in summer.

General

School colours are maroon gold and navy.

- Students and parents can choose combinations of items from the above list.
- Students attending public events are encouraged wear school uniform.
- All items to be in school colours unless otherwise indicated ie sports day
- Parents wishing to dress children in non-official school material may request exemption for that item providing it is in school colours.
- Uniform items have been chosen specifically to avoid the pursuit of fashions.
- All accessories e.g. socks, tights, hair ties, head bands, are to be in colours that complement the school colours.
- Closed-toed sandals or similar closed footwear is acceptable.
- If a student has reasonable cause to attend school out of uniform on a particular day, then it is requested the parent forward a note to school.
- Year 7 students, with teachers' involvement, design their own jacket and polo shirt. The Year 7 jacket and polo shirts will be predominately navy blue with a gold logo.
- Body piercings are not permitted for safety reasons, with the exception of a single stud or sleeper in each ear. Earrings which "dangle" or hang below the ear are not permitted.
- Students can wear a single necklace, inside their clothing.
- Students are permitted to wear a watch.
- For safety reasons, students may be required to remove or cover jewellery for sport and physical education.
